## VÍMARIA LEGACY & FAMILY ROOTS

Named for our grandparents, Vittorio and Maria Sangiacomo, ViMaria is more than a wine. It's a love story, a legacy, and a tribute to where it all began. When Vittorio and Maria made their home in Sonoma Valley in 1927, they planted more than roots in the soil. They planted the foundation for a life built around family, farming, and connection. As a cornerstone of our Legacy Collection, ViMaria reflects the courage, dedication, and joy they passed down to each generation.

Crafted from just six special barrels each year, this wine is bold, rich, and elegant. It is rooted in the values that guide us—family, stewardship, and sharing something meaningful with others.

## WHERE THE VINTAGE BEGINS – THE SONOMA COAST WINES

A starting point for the vintage, our Sonoma Coast Chardonnay and Pinot Noir are the first wines crafted each season by our winemaker, James MacPhail. They reflect our signature style—vibrant, layered, and expressive—bringing together fruit from across five of our estate vineyards. If each vineyard is like a child; unique in personality and special in character, then these wines are the full family gathered together at one table. They offer a unified, dynamic expression, each site contributing its own unique personality to the final composition, capturing both the range and depth of the lands we farm. After all, there's no such thing as choosing a favorite when every vineyard brings something special to the glass.

## A VINEYARD THAT STARTED IT ALL – GREEN ACRES

Planted in 1969, Green Acres Vineyard is a living link between past and present, a site that all four generations have farmed together. It was our family's first vineyard and remains one of our most treasured sites, producing Chardonnay with a signature balance of richness and elegance. Composed of fruit from four distinct blocks of different ages—each its own "generation" of vines—this wine tells its story in layers. Every block adds its own nuance, weaving together a tapestry of flavor that reflects more than fifty years of care and family history in every glass.

*From Our Family to Yours*

Wine holds a special place in our lives together. It's meant to be shared, to enhance a meal, and to transform simple moments into lasting memories, and it invites us to revisit those memories again and again with each bottle opened. Our grandfather Vittorio understood this when he planted 100 vines in his front yard, not as a business, but for the pure joy of growing something to share with others. That same spirit of connection lives on in every bottle.

THE 2023 VINTAGE

The year kicked off with consistent winter rainfalls, replenishing the soil and providing ample water reserves, followed by cooler-than-average spring and summer weather. The slow and steady growing season; our longest in 20 years, allowing for extended flavor development in the berries. An autumn heat spike provided the final push of ripeness, crucial in achieving ideal phenolic development of the skins and seeds, yielding grapes with intense flavors and ideally balanced acidity. Some years bring a plentiful harvest, and some years yield truly extraordinary flavors. But not often do we get both in the same year. This rare combination was due in large part to an exceedingly long and cool growing season, making for a truly remarkable vintage. As always, harvest took place in the early morning hours, during the coolest part of the day, to preserve the freshness, vibrancy, and balance in every cluster.

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2023 SONOMA COAST CHARDONNAY

Bright straw in color, this Chardonnay opens with enticing aromas of flinty wet stone, fresh straw, and ripe Bosc pear, lifted by orange and lime zest. On the palate, crisp white peach, green apple, and crunchy stone fruit are complemented by delicate white flowers and a subtle saline note, giving the wine a savory, mouthwatering character. Medium-bodied through the mid-palate yet charged with energy, it finishes with persistent mineral lift and a vibrant, lingering finish reminiscent of the Sonoma Coast's cool, coastal terroir.

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2023 SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

Dark garnet in color, this Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir opens with rich aromas of dark ripe plum, cherry cassis, and mulled holiday spices, accented by delicate rose petal and violet notes. On the palate, a vibrant core of red and dark fruits unfolds with black plum, cherry, and cassis with rose petals, violets, and warm spice. Medium to full-bodied, the wine is savory, vibrant and mouthwatering, offering a plush texture and a lingering, energetic finish.

**BARREL AGING**

Aged 11 months in 34% new oak, medium-toast French barrels from hand-selected coopers.

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2023 GREEN ACRES VINEYARD CHARDONNAY

This light golden-hued Chardonnay opens with fragrant aromas of ripe Bosc pear, green apple, and orange pith, lifted by lime zest, delicate white flowers, and a subtle hint of fresh grass. On the palate, zippy, energetic flavors of lime, green apple, and pear are framed by a pronounced mineral core of flinty wet stone and a whisper of petrichor. Medium-bodied through the mid-palate, the wine is crisp and mouthwatering, finishing with persistent energy and a generous, lingering finish.

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2023 VÍMARIA PINOT NOIR

Swirl this violet-hued powerful beauty to reveal fragrant aromas of freshly mashed strawberries, red plum, and cherry coulis with a backdrop of forest floor, holiday spices and orange rind adding depth and intrigue. Medium to full-bodied and boldly expressive, the palate opens with high-toned red fruits, including Bing cherry and fresh red plum, interwoven with brambly forest notes, fresh pine, and bright orange rind. Plush tannins and lively acidity give structure, elegance and energy, while mouthwatering savory flavors extend into a long, vibrant finish. This Pinot Noir captures a signature style and balance of fruit, spice, earth, and floral undertones.
